Performance Objective 1: In the 2016-2017 school year, Brock Elementary will increase Science STAAR performance by at least 10 percentage points, leading to an increase in students Level II (met standard), Level III (advanced standard) and growth measure for all student groups and ensure that the English Language Learners (ELL) student group and the Special Education student group attain no less than 65% of students meeting standards.

Performance Objective 2: In the 2016-2017 school year, Brock Elementary will increase Math STAAR performance by at least 10 percentage points, leading to an increase in students Level II (met standard), Level III (advanced standard), and growth measure for all student groups and ensure that the English Language Learners (ELL) student group and the Special Education student group attain no less than 65% of students meeting standards.

Performance Objective 3: In the 2016-2017 school year, Brock Elementary will increase Reading STAAR performance by at least 10 percentage points, leading to an increase in students Level II (met standard), Level III (advanced standard), and growth measure for all student groups and ensure that the English Language Learners (ELL) student group and the Special Education student group attain no less than 65% of students meeting standards.

Performance Objective 4: In the 2016-2017 school year, Brock Elementary will increase Writing STAAR performance by at least 10 percentage points, leading to an increase in students Level II (met standard), Level III (advanced standard), and growth measure for all student groups and ensure that the Hispanic student group and the Special Education student group attain no less than 65% of students meeting standards.

Performance Objective 5: In the 2016-2017 school year, Brock Elementary will increase available technology in Kindergarten through second grade to align to the district one to one initiative. Students will create a product at least once per six weeks.

Goal 2: We will provide students with multiple avenues for specialized instruction and opportunities to advance at their own pace.

Performance Objective 1: In the 2016-2017 school year, Brock Elementary will provide time in the school day for 100% of our students to participate in tier time for intervention and extension, leading to an increase in students Level II (met standard), Level III (advanced standard) and growth measure for all student groups, ensuring the Hispanic student group and the Special Education student group attain no less than 65% of students meeting standards.

Goal 3: We will equip teachers with the resources, training, and time necessary to achieve our strategic objectives.

Performance Objective 1: In the 2016-2017, Brock Elementary will provide 100% of our teachers with resources, training and time necessary to carry out the district commitments, leading to an increase in students Level II (met standard), Level III (advanced), standard and growth measure for all student groups.

Performance Objective 1: In the 2016-2017 school year, Brock Elementary will implement rigorous instruction and high-level questioning in all core subject areas on a daily basis through the Thinking Pathways model, leading to an increase in advanced standard, as evident in 95% of classroom walkthroughs.

Performance Objective 1: In the 2016-2017 school year, 100% of Brock Elementary students will have the opportunity to participate in programs/clubs of choice.
